

**MINUTES OF THE DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE (DDC) MEETING HELD ON 6<sup>TH</sup> APRIL, 2023 AT 11.30 A.M. IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE , KARIMGANJ.**

Members Present – As per Annexure "A"

The meeting was chaired by Sri Mridul Yadav, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Karimganj. At the outset he welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

Before going to discussion the Deputy Commissioner appraised the house about the achievement on DMI of CM Dashboard. Most of the department could not reach the target inspite of giving full efforts but performing well except two to three departments. The department namely, Transport & Education has achieved full target. The Deputy Commissioner thanked the Heads of both the departments & their teams for their achievement & also honoured them by felicitating with a certificate of appreciation in the meeting.

Further, All the Head of Departments were appraised about the forthcoming Deputy Commissioner's conference in May,2023 to be held at Tinsukia. The Chairman requested them to up-to date the action taken report on decision & direction of the last Deputy Commissioner's conference & submit report accordingly.

Thereafter the review was held department wise on the activities for the month of April, 2023 which were recorded as follows-

1. **PWRD ( North /South/ Badarpur):** Regarding status of schemes under Assam Mala, The Executive Engineer appraised that land acquisition is required at some places. He was requested to write a letter to District Administration mentioning the pin point locations of required land. The individual notice to be served against the same from the district administration. The ADC (Revenue) is requested to take necessary action accordingly.

Regarding PMGSY it was found that the progress of 3 nos of schemes out of 7 is very poor compared to others. The Executive Engineer was instructed to take necessary step to gear up the progress.

Regarding Badarpur –Aadorkona road which is a long pending work, the progress of which is very slow & there is several public complaints about the same which was also discussed in the visit of Guardian Minister's review meeting held on November, 2022. The Executive Engineer was instructed to write a letter to the contractor concerned to complete the work immediately with a copy to the Hon'ble Guardian Minister.

Regarding BADP, the progress of work of schemes was reviewed & found that the progress of 1 no of scheme out of 4 is satisfactory. The Executive Engineer was instructed to take immediate step to complete all the schemes.

Action: The Executive Engineer, Kxj

2. **NH:** The Executive Engineer appraised that the work of the scheme viz "Improvement of existing single/ Intermediate lane of NH-44" has already been completed. Further in a query regarding the proposal for one time improvement of the existing road from Hathikhira to 20 no. road via Lowairpoa the Executive Engineer appraised that proposal has already been submitted to the Govt of India.

3. **TRANSPORT:** Discussion was held on the activities of the Transport department it was decided that a meeting in connection with road safety measures with all road departments to be convened early. The DTO was requested to take action accordingly.

Regarding, vehicle scrappage policy DTO briefed the house about the same in detail & requested the departments to take step accordingly if any such type of vehicles belong to their departments.

4. **PHE:** The Executive Engineer, PHE , reported the progress of different activities up-to the month of March as follows –

Regarding retrofitting out of 702 nos of schemes 224 nos has already been completed, progress in between 70% to 99% is 68 nos, above 50% is 56 nos & less than 50% is 12 nos. The discussion was held regarding mismatch of the target with the DMI format of the last financial year. In this connection the Deputy Commissioner instructed all the District Heads of the department to confirm the proper target of different activities related to their department in the DMI of CM Dashboard in the initial stage of current financial year. If any discrepancies noticed, take up the matter with CM dashboard cell.

Action: 1. The Executive Engineer, Kxj

5. **WATER RESOURCES:** The progress of different schemes was reviewed in the meeting. It was found that no satisfactory progress has been made against under SOPD (ODS) 2021-22. The Executive Engineer was requested to take necessary steps for completion of all ongoing schemes as the monsoon season is approaching.

Further in a query on the stock of materials to be required for flood protection measures, the Executive Engineer appraised that there is sufficient stock of materials with them. The Executive Engineer was instructed to take constant watch on the vulnerable places of the district.

Participating the discussion Executive Engineer, PWRD (North/ South/ Badarpur) appraised the house regarding erosion at dyke due to unauthorized nearby sand lifting. The Deputy Commissioner asked detailed report with exact locations of the same to take necessary steps to prevent the erosion.

Action: The Executive Engineer, Water Resources, Kxj

5. **APDCL:** Regarding lose powerline the officials present in the meeting appraised that survey & clearance of power line by cutting tree branches to avoid any untoward incidents is going on in the district. In this connection the Deputy Commissioner instructed all the department to appraise the APDCL authority if any issue like lose wire, tree branches which are required to be clear in their respective offices.

Regarding payment of outstanding bill of PHE against some projects the Deputy Commissioner instructed the APDCL authority not to disconnect the power as the department will clear payment shortly.

Action : All Head of Departments, Kxj.

6. **FISHERY:** The different activities of the department was reviewed in the meeting. It was pointed out in the meeting that flow of storm water in different Nala/ drainage & small tributaries affected due to fishing by nets and other methods. The Deputy Commissioner instructed the DFDO & water resources department to take action in such cases immediately .

The DFDO was also instructed to take steps for no fishing in different water bodies in the district as the breeding season has started.

Action : The DFDO, Fishery, Kxj

7. **AGRICULTURE:** A discussion was held on paddy procurement. It was found that the performance of the district is very poor and also observed that only few farmers have been registered from Patherkandi & Ratabari area. The DAO was instructed to take necessary steps to enhance the procurement immediately.

As regards the formation of FPO , it was reported that out of 12 nos only 2 have been formed & 3 nos under process. The Deputy Commissioner instructed the DAO to submit the detailed report on the matter immediately.

Action: The DAO, Agriculture, Kxj

8. **T& CP:** Discussion was held in respect of PMAY-U , it was reported by the department that out of 9766 nos of houses only 4061 nos completed.

The department was instructed to take immediate step to complete the all houses early.

Action: Dy. Director, T&CP,Kxj

9. **SOIL CONSERVATION:** The DO , reported that the works of the scheme under RIDF 2022-23 Meda-II is in progress aout 90% & it will be completed within a week.

He was instructed to fix a date for field verification of the project.

Action: The DO, Soil Conservation,Kxj

10. **EXCISE:** the Superintendent of Excise (I/c) appraised the house about revenue collection till the month of March, 2023 is Rs. 27,03,60,416.98 i.e. 92.82% against targeted Rs.29.12 cr.

11. **HANDLOOM & TEXTILES:** The Asstt. Director was instructed to conducted drive to prevent selling of imported Gamusa in the district during ensuing Bihu festival.

Action: The Asstt. Director, H & T,Kxj

12. **ANIMAL HUSBANDRY & VETY.:** The District Vety. Officer reported that the vaccination programme is going on and also appraised that there are necessary stock of required medicines in the district.

13. **DICC:** The G.M. appraised the house that under PMEGP out of sponsored 165 nos . of applications 80 nos has been sanctioned by the banks up to March 2023.

Further, regarding Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises Scheme,he appraised that out of targeted 150 nos 69 nos sponsored to Bank and 19 nos already sanctioned by the bank.

Regarding pending cases, he was instructed to take up the matter with LDM as well as pursue the same with the bank branches.

It was also decided that all the issues of the bank linkage scheme should be placed in next DCC meeting which to be held shortly.

Action: The G.M., DICC,Kxj
