

**MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING FOR THE MONTHS OF JUNE AND JULY, 2025 HELD ON 07-07-2025 AT 11:00 A.M IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE DISTRICT COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, SRIBHUMI**

The meeting was chaired by Shri Pradeep Kumar Dwivedi, IAS, District Commissioner, Sribhumi.

At the outset the District Development Commissioner, Sribhumi welcomed all the members and officials present in the meeting.

Thereafter, the District Commissioner reviewed the progress of works of various departments and decisions and directions in the meeting was recorded department wise as follows:

**1. DICC:** The District Commissioner reviewed the progress of various programmes/activities such as PMEGP, PMFMFPE, PM-Vishwakarma, CMAAA, etc. On a query from the District Commissioner, the official present in the meeting appraised that 25 nos. of applications have been received till date. The District Commissioner instructed the depts. to submit detailed report of programmes/schemes under the depts. reflecting bank wise pending applications.

**2. Public Health Engineering:** The District Commissioner reviewed about the progress of SBM-G in the district. The District Commissioner, instructed the CEO, ZP to verify the pending DBT applications before the next DDC Meeting. The CEO was further instructed to issue a notification for ensuring that the Jal Mitras record daily readings of electricity meter and water flow meters for a minimum of 25 days every month, failing which may result in the withholding of their remuneration.

**3. PWD Roads:** The District Commissioner, reviewed the progress of works under Asom Mala, MMUPPNA, MMPNA, MMPPNA etc. The E.E PWRD Karimganj North-South TRD appraised that 6 nos. of schemes has been sanctioned in the Tea Garden areas. The District Commissioner instructed the ADC (Revenue) to visit the site along with the E.E, PWRD Karimganj North-South TRD and explore the possibilities for acquisition of land for implementation of Asom Mala scheme in the Basail area.

Upon review of activities of the depts. the E.E PWRD Patharkandi-Ratabari TRD appraised that survey works for PMGSY-IV is going on.

**4. PWD (Building):** The District Commissioner reviewed the progress of major works under the depts. The District Commissioner expressed dissatisfaction due to non-submission of P&E of the boundary wall of DSA Swimming pool. Further, the E.E was directed to examine the feasibility of renovating 4 nos. of rooms in the additional Circuit House into 2 suite rooms. In this regard, the E.E was directed to meet the DDC. The DC instructed CDC, R.K Nagar to visit the 2 nos. of Mini Stadiums at R.K Nagar and Patharkandi and the New Model Women College at R.K Nagar. The ADC (Education) was directed to enquire the works of LP Schools under RIDF.

**5. Education:** As regards rationalization of teachers, the District Commissioners instructed the depts. to place the teachers at their original place of posting. Further, it was instructed that rationalization of teachers may be done category wise across all levels of schools.

- 6. Health:** The progress of works under PM ABHIM was reviewed in the meeting. The DPM appraised that out of 74 nos. of sanctioned works 4 nos. of works is in process of retender and approval for shifting of sites for 4 nos. of works is still awaited. The DC instructed the depts., to ensure running tap water connection in the Civil Hospital. Further, the Civil Hospital administration was directed to strictly monitor the hospital premises through CCTVs to ensure cleanliness and hygiene. In this regard, the depts. was also directed to create awareness and impose fine on loiterers for violation. The E.E, PWD Building was instructed to visit the Civil Hospital and the residential quarters for providing round the clock water supply.
- 7. Women and Child Development:** On review of works of Model AWCs, the DC directed the depts. to notify the remaining ALCCs under South Karimganj LAC. They were also directed to transfer fund for execution of works of AWCs under South Karimganj LAC by 14<sup>th</sup> July.
- 8. Power:** The depts. appraised that the Gamaria Sub station will be inaugurated by this month. As regards, Bazarghat sub station the depts stated that there civil work related to boundary wall which was damaged needs to be repaired. On a query from the DC, the AGM appraised that installation of free connections will start soon.
- 9. Food Public Distribution & Consumer Affairs:** The various activities of the depts. was reviewed. As regards distribution of rice under NFSA the depts. appraised that rice allocated for months June to August, 2025 has already been distributed. The Dy. Director i/c further appraised that steps are being taken to track irregular NFSA beneficiaries. The depts. also reported that paddy procurement so far is 4975.6 Qntl.
- 10. P&RD:** The CEO, ZP appraised the house about the various ongoing schemes of the depts. viz. PMAY (G), 15<sup>th</sup> FC, NSAP, etc. As regards, MGNREGA Adhaar Seeding, the CEO, ZP appraised that the achievement is 99.79% and percentage eligible for ABPS against total nos. of workers is 94.73%.
- 11. Agriculture:** The official present in the meeting appraised that Aadhaar Authentication under PMKISAN is 47008 nos., EKYC is 46612 nos. and ABPS is 46665 nos. As regards PMFBY for Kharif 2025 it was reported that the achievement is 60% and enrolment is going on.
- 12. Irrigation:** The progress of works of various schemes of both the divisions were reviewed. The E.E, Karimganj North South division, appraised that the progress of 1 no. of ongoing scheme is 10% and works against another 3 nos. are yet to be started.
- 13. Fisheries:** The activities of schemes under PMMSY was reviewed and depts. was directed to expedite the works for achieving targets. As regards KCC, the DFDO appraised that out of 10 nos. dispatched to bank, 1 no. have been sanctioned for FY 2025-26.
- 14. Water Resources:** The progress of works of all the schemes under the depts. was reviewed in the meeting. The DDC directed the E.E. to complete the works within stipulated date of completion.
- 15. Sports:** The DSO appraised the house about the various activities of the depts.
- 16. Excise:** The Supdt. Of Excise reported that revenue collection of the department is Rs. 4.62 Cr. upto the month of June, 2025 out of the target of Rs. 39.69 Cr.
- 17. Transport:** The DTO appraised that revenue collection of the department is Rs. 5.54 Cr. so far out of the target of Rs. 26.67 Cr.

- 18. Handloom and Textiles:** The Asstt. Director appraised about the activities taken under schemes viz. Swanirbhar Nari, PMJJBY & PMSBY. The Asstt. Director further appraised that, awareness programme amongst the weavers is going on under PMJJBY & PMSBY.
- 19. AH&Vety:** The DVO appraised about the activities of the deptt. On a query from the DDC, the DVO informed that vaccination is going on in the district.
- 20. T&CP:** The Deputy Director, T&CP, appraised the house that 8489 nos. of houses completed out of 11150 nos. under PMAY-U. The District Dev. Commissioner directed the department to complete the remaining work soon.
- 21. Sericulture:** The various activities of the deptt. was reviewed. The official present in the meeting reported that under SODP nursery preparation is going on at ECC, Khola and ECC, Tajpur.
- 22. SMB:** The Executive Officer appraised that activities of the deptt. such as collection of P.Tax, Door to door waste collection etc. are going on.
- 23. Soil Conservation:** The DO reported that 1 no. of scheme sanctioned under RIDF-XXX is yet to be started.
- 24. Legal Metrology:** The District Dev. Commissioner directed the deptt. to conduct regular inspection of scales and metres at Fair Price Shops and FCI.
- 25. Labour:** The District Dev. Commissioner instructed the deptt. to carry out activities of “*Mukhya Mantrir Eti Koli Duti Paat*” as per scheduled timeline to ensure that no eligible beneficiary is left out.
- 26. PWD NH:** The EE appraised about the progress of works of 2 nos. of ongoing schemes under the deptt. is 99% and 76.50%.

At the end the meeting ended with vote of thanks from the chair.
