

**MINUTES OF THE DDC MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF SEPTEMBER, 2025
HELD ON 08-09-2025 AT 11:00 A.M IN THE CONFERENCE HALL OF THE
DISTRICT COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE, SRIBHUMI**

The meeting was chaired by Shri Pradeep Kumar Dwivedi, IAS, District Commissioner, Sribhumi.

At the outset the District Development Commissioner, Sribhumi welcomed all the members and officials present in the meeting.

Thereafter, the District Commissioner reviewed the progress of works of various departments and decisions and directions in the meeting was recorded department wise as follows:

- 1. Public Health Engineering:** On a query from the District Commissioner, the Executive Engineer appraised about the status of defunct schemes and the steps taken for operationalization of the same. The E.E was directed to resolve all issues within a week. As regards, construction of CMSC in Health Centres, the Health deptt. requested the E.E to share the list of the projects where the works are going on. Regarding Jal Baithak, the E.E appraised that out of planned 58 nos., 56 nos. has been conducted so far. The District Commissioner directed the E.E to dispose the DBT applications at the earliest.
- 2. Health:** The District Commissioner directed the Deptt. to submit report on the private ambulances operating in the district and take necessary steps for regulating such ambulances immediately. The DPM informed that Hon'ble MLAs will adopt 100 nos. of T.B patients under Nikshay Mitra per LAC. The DPM also informed that new para-medical staff will join tentatively by November, 2025. Further, it was informed that dates for LAC wise Mega Health Camps have been finalized. Regarding TG Wage Compensation Scheme, the District Commissioner directed the deptt. to submit a detailed report. Further, the District Commissioner reviewed the physical progress of various on-going schemes of the deptt.
- 3. PWD (Building):** The District Commissioner expressed displeasure over failure of the Executive Engineer to submit estimate of boundary wall of Swimming Pool, Additional Circuit House, DC Bungalow, etc. in spite of repeated directions. The District Commissioner requested the DDC to issue show cause to the E.E and inform the Commissioner & Secretary, PWD (Building) recommending his suspension for his failure in carrying out his duties and repeatedly remaining absent in DDC Meetings as well as in other meetings. The District Commissioner also requested the DDC to communicate with AGM, APDCL, Hailakandi Division to remain present in DDC Meeting as a part of RK Nagar falls under their jurisdiction.
- 4. PWD Roads:** The District Commissioner, raised concern regarding delay in completion of works of Nilmoni Road. The District Commissioner requested DDC to conduct an enquiry for the delay. He was also requested to convey to the Commissioner & Secretary, PWD (Roads) regarding delay in execution of the work.
- 5. LDM:** The DDC requested the LDM to look into the applications of beneficiaries sponsored by different departments and take steps for disbursal of loans to genuine and eligible beneficiaries on time.

- 6. Agriculture:** The official present in the meeting appraised that Aadhaar Authentication under PMKISAN is 42,881 nos., EKYC is 42,881 nos. and ABPS is 42,881 nos. As regards PMFBY for Kharif 2025 it was reported that the achievement is 113%. Further, he appraised that Digital Crop Survey under Agristack for R.K Nagar Revenue Circle is going on and digital crop survey completed so far is 32%.
- 7. Women and Child Development:** The DDC reviewed the progress of works of Model AWCs under NIDA, RIDF-I, RIDF-II, SC-BC and SOPD. The DDC directed the deptt. to expedite the works of the schemes. The DPM also appraised the status of PMMVY for FY 2025-26 which is 31%.
- 8. PWD NH:** The E.E appraised that one no. of scheme at Existing NH-44 stretch of Lowairpoa Bypass is going on and physical progress is 78%.
- 9. Irrigation:** The progress of works of various schemes of both the divisions were reviewed. The E.E, RK Nagar-Patharkandi Division, appraised that 2 nos. of schemes are going on under PMKSY-HKKP-SMI for the year 2022-23 and the progress so far are 85% and 80% respectively. Further, the E.E, North Sribhumi-South Sribhumi Division stated that works of 3 Nos. of schemes under RIDF-XXX (NABARD) for the year 2024-25 are going on and work order has been issued against 1 scheme. However, works of the scheme is yet to be started by the contractor.
- 10. Fisheries:** The activities of schemes under PMMSY was reviewed and deptt. was directed to expedite the works for achieving targets. As regards KCC, the DFDO appraised that out of 12 nos. dispatched to bank, 1 no. have been sanctioned for FY 2025-26.
- 11. Water Resources:** The progress of works of all the schemes under the deptt. was reviewed in the meeting. The EE appraised that 3 nos. of schemes are going on. The DDC directed the E.E. to complete all on-going works within stipulated date of completion.
- 12. Excise:** The Supdt. of Excise reported that revenue collection of the department is Rs. 7.57 Cr. upto the month of August, 2025 out of the target of Rs. 39.69 Cr.
- 13. Transport:** The DTO appraised that revenue collection of the department is Rs. 9.44 Cr. so far out of the target of Rs. 26.66 Cr.
- 14. DICC:** The G.M appraised about the progress of various programmes/activities such as PMEGP, PMFMFPE, PM-Vishwakarma, CMAAA, etc.
- 15. Power:** The DDC reviewed the progress of works of 4 nos. of sub-stations. As regards, PM Surya Ghar, the AGM appraised that 498 nos. of solar modules have been installed in the district so far.
- 16. Handloom and Textiles:** The Asstt. Director appraised about the activities taken under schemes viz. Swanirbhar Nari, PMJJBY & PMSBY. The Asstt. Director further appraised that, awareness programme amongst the weavers is going on under PMJJBY & PMSBY.
- 17. AH&Vety:** The DVO appraised about the activities of the deptt. On a query from the DDC, the DVO informed that target of FMD (vaccination) has been achieved.
- 18. T&CP:** The Deputy Director, T&CP, appraised the house that 8684 nos. of houses completed out of 11150 nos. under PMAY-U. The District Dev. Commissioner directed the department to complete the remaining work soon.

19. Sericulture: The various activities of the deptt. was reviewed. The official present in the meeting reported that under SODP nursery preparation is going on at ECC, Kholā and ECC, Tajpur.

20. Labour: The Inspector informed that digitization process of “*Mukhya Mantrir Eti Koli Duti Paat*” applications is going on. Further, the DDC directed the deptt. to take up matter of bonus to Tea Garden workers with concerned Tea Garden authorities.

21. Taxes: The Asstt. Commissioner of Taxes reported that out of targeted Rs. 65.70 Cr. an amount of Rs. 30.25 Cr has been collected so far from all sources.

At the end the meeting ended with vote of thanks from the chair.
